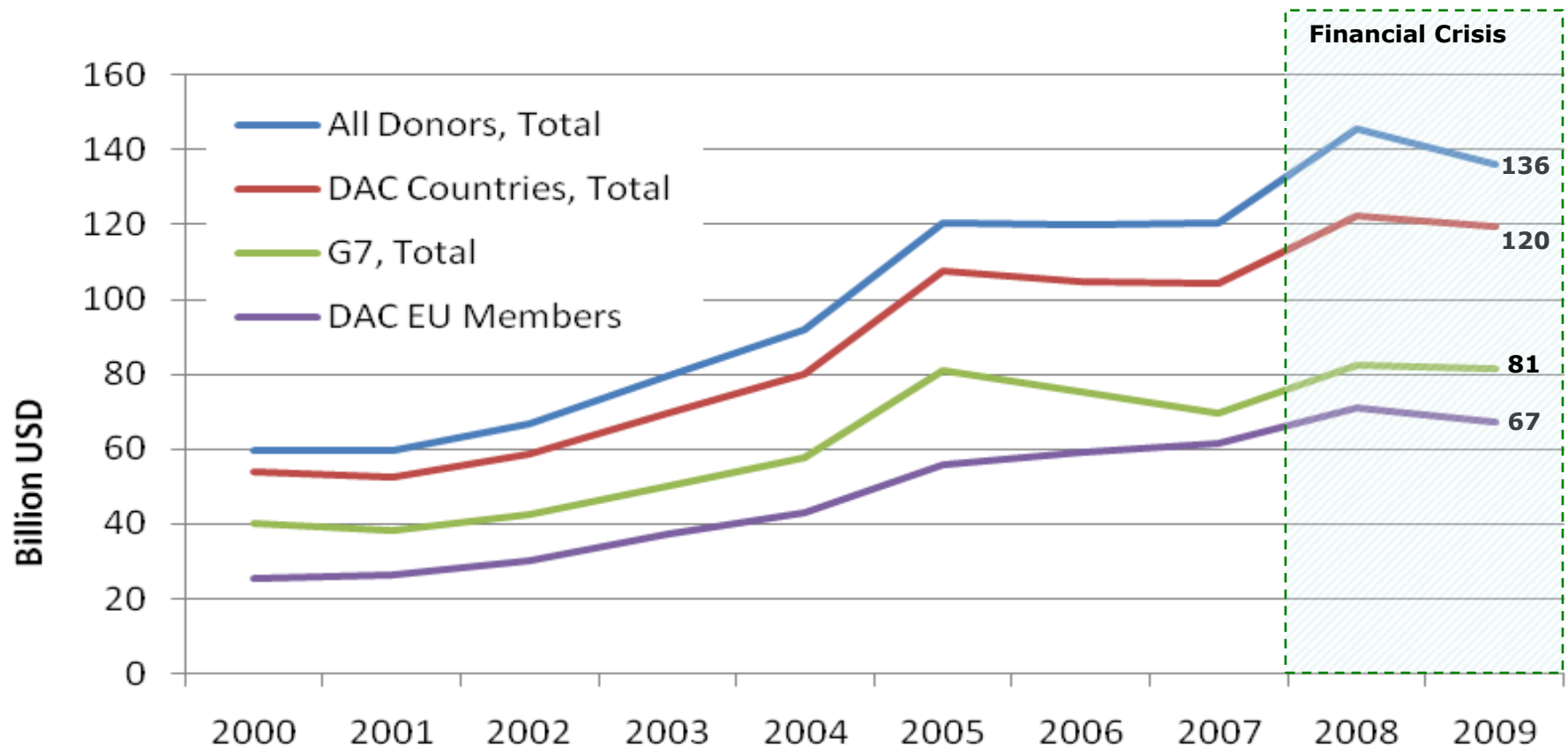

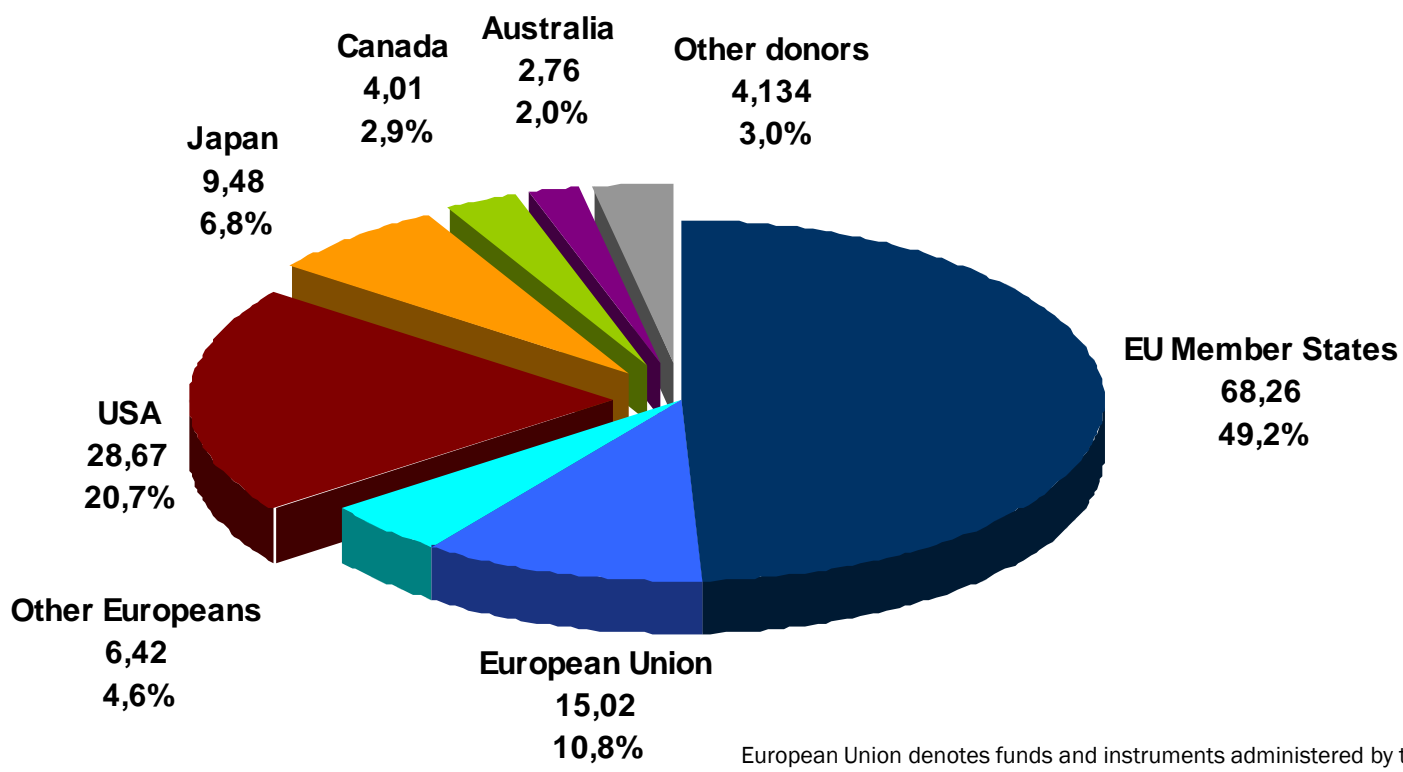

## Main donors of global ODA net disbursements in billion USD (2009)

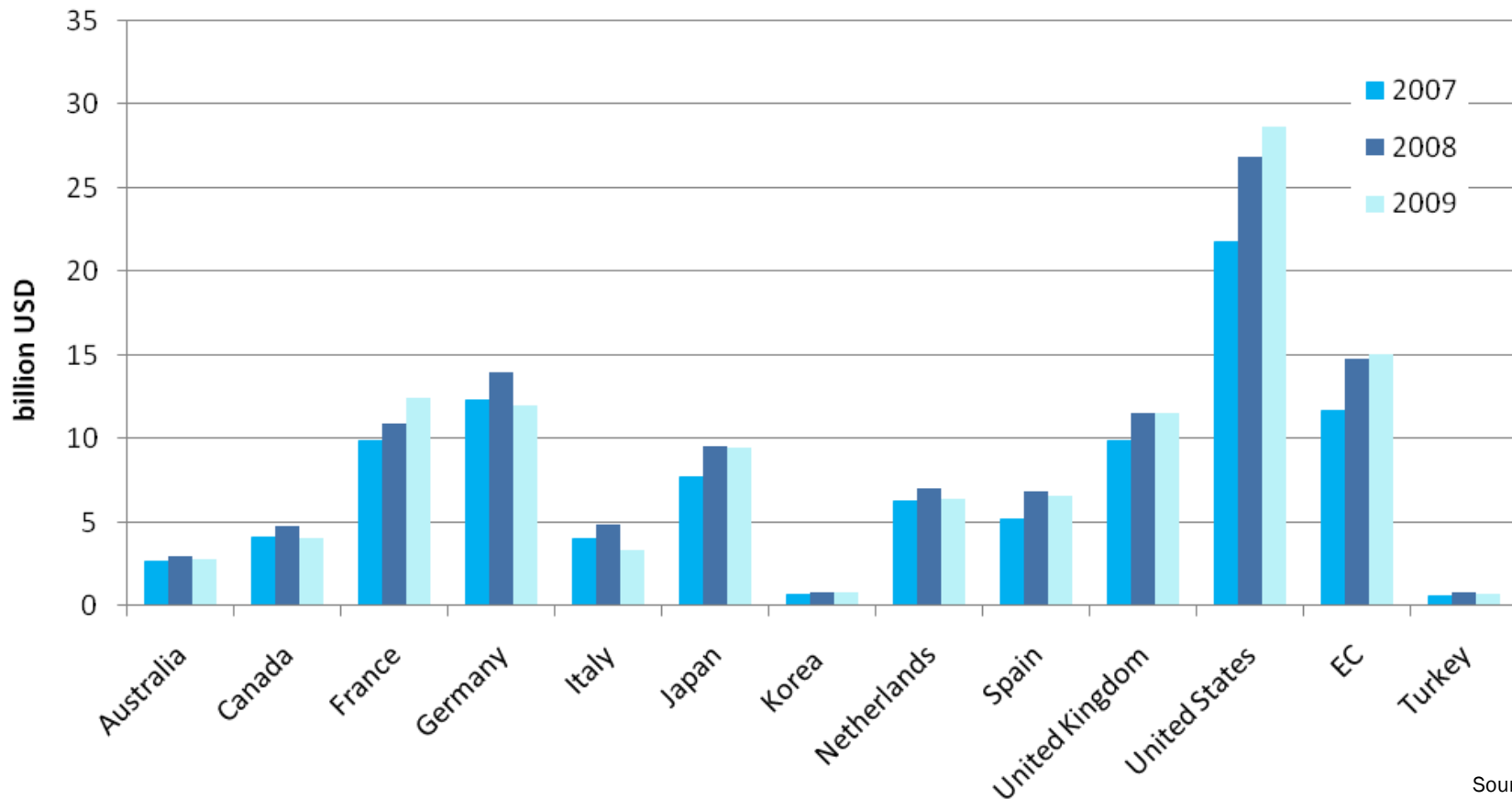

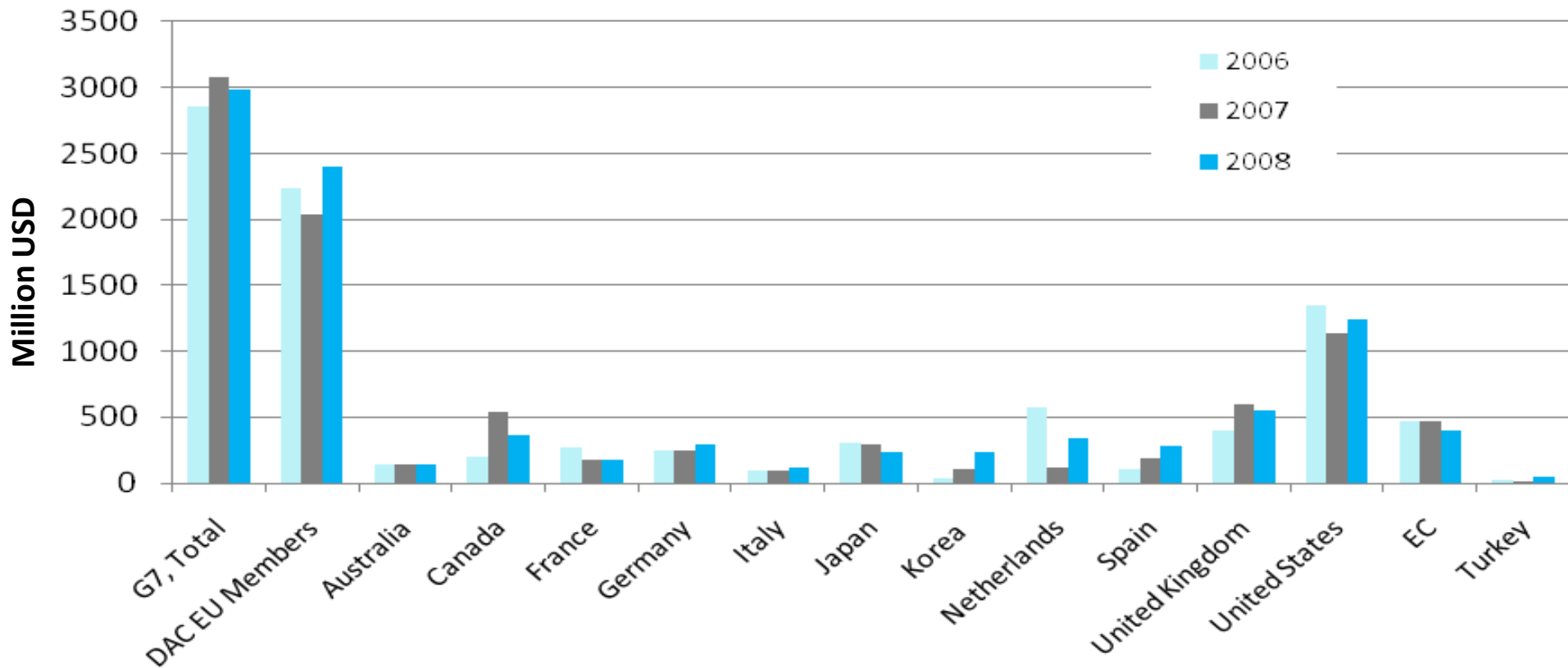
net disbursements in billion USD (2009)

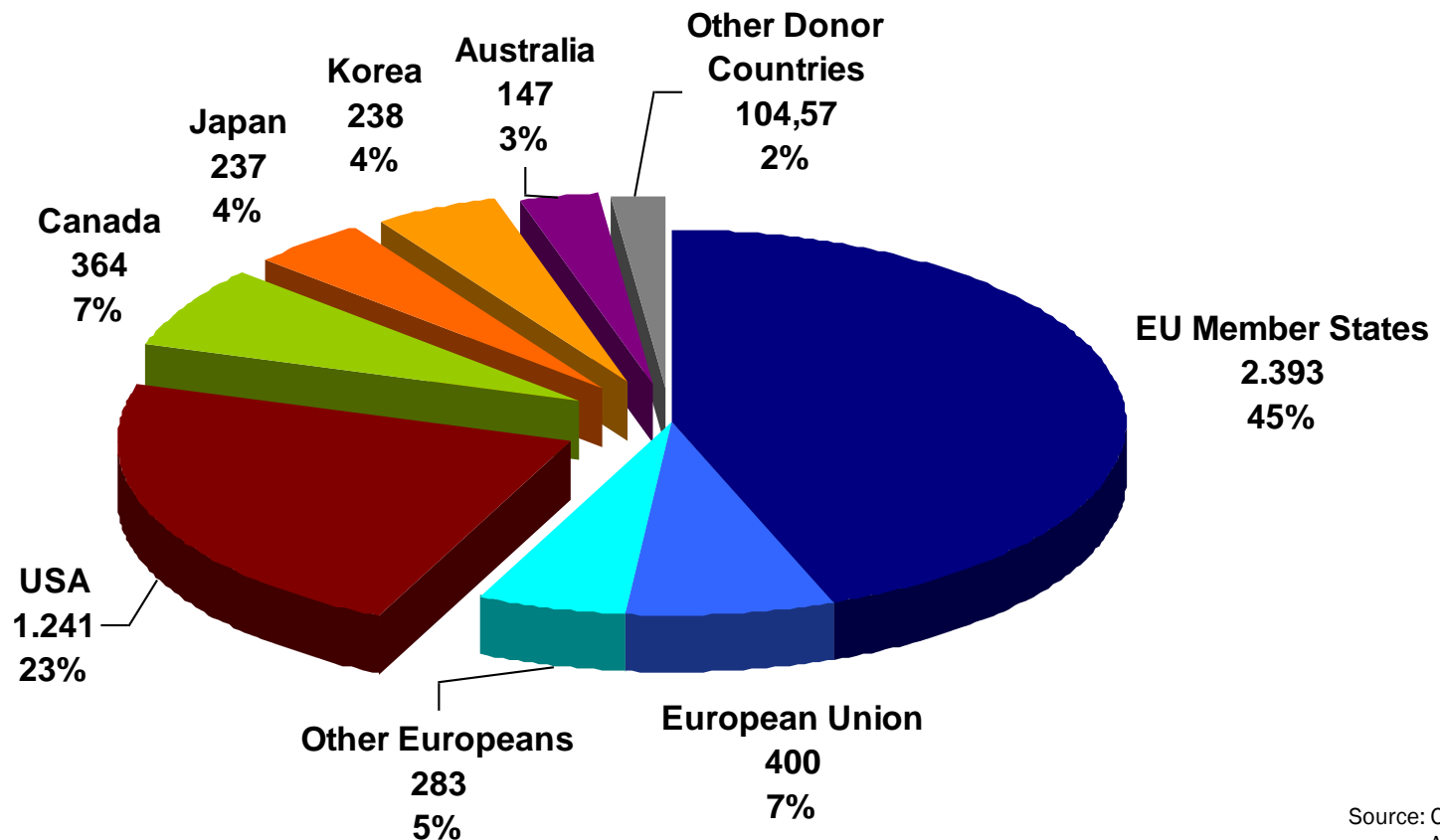
### Health ODA efforts

### Funding Trends for ICPD



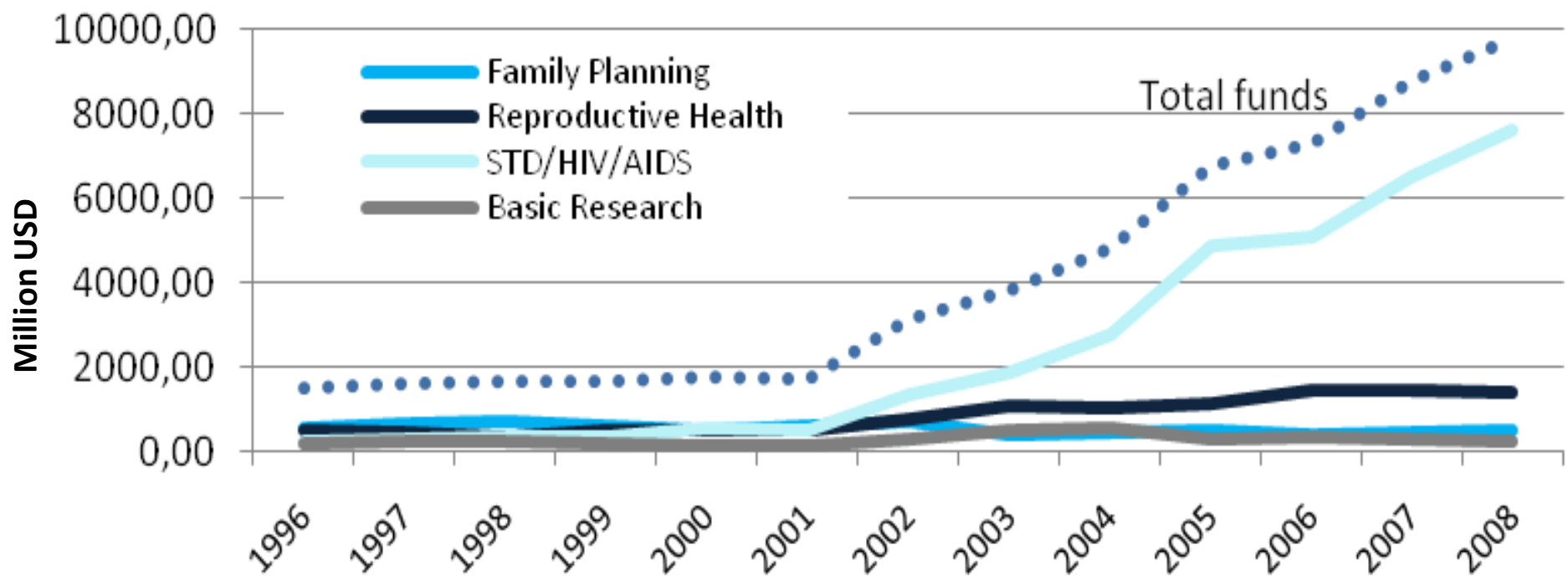


## Methodology

While OECD/DAC collects population project/programme details for selected CRS codes, the UNFPA/NIDI Resource Flows project collects additional data necessary to more comprehensively track resource flows for population activities.

The RF 2008 questionnaire refers to general contributions for population to intermediate organisations not approached by OECD/DAC; additional CRS codes that may partially cover population activities; a breakdown of the STD/HIV/AIDS sub-categories, expenditures specifically for young people and finally estimated future expenditures for population from 2009 and 2010 inclusive.

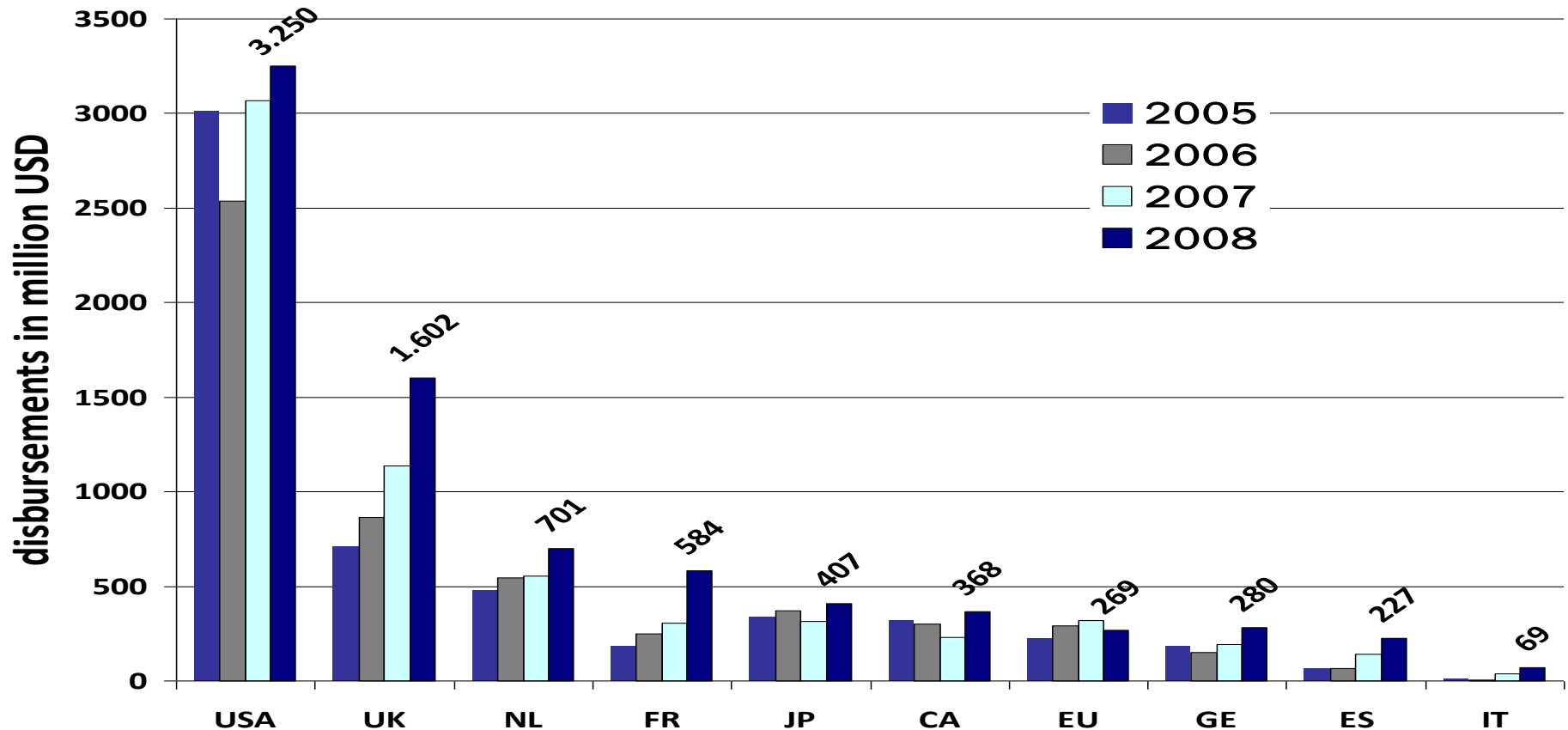
